Emergency!

What to do if you've got no water?

You turn on the tap and... nothing! There's really never a convenient time to be out of water and in most cases we consider it an emergency. First, make sure nothing is leaking around your water systems. If it is, either bypass the system or turn off the main water and the power to the well pump. If there are no leaks, next check your circuit breaker, check for a clogged cartridge filter, and look for any running hoses or toilets. If everything looks good, shut off the main water valve to the house for 30 minutes, and turn it back on. If you now have water, then chances are your well was just low. This happens often in the summer as we start to get drought conditions and use more water. If this doesn't solve the problem give us call us at 800-732-7468. Question:

My water pressure is low, what do I do?

Answer:

Improving your water pressure can often be an easy fix that just requires a repair to your pressure tank for your incoming water (or installing one if you don't have one). Sometimes, with well water, we recommend addition of a booster pump or a pump upgrade to one with a higher gallons per minute rating to get a higher flow.
