# Ready for Spring?



Spring is finally here! While you're cleaning up your house and yard for the season, don't overlook your water treatment and pump systems. As we move into the higher water demand season, whether it's irrigation or pool filling, now is a great time to make sure everything is in good working order. An annual check by Water-Flo can make sure all the systems are in good repair and working correctly. Here are a few things to look for and consider testing:

- At the tap: It's recommended to test your well water for bacteria at least annually (per The State of Connecticut Department of Public Health Environmental Health Section, Private Well Program), or whenever flood waters or surface runoff inundates the well. Also, if you are getting ready to sell your house, mortgage companies often require at least a total coliform test before the sale for homes with well water.
- Outside: Inspect your well cap and casing for cracks or holes, including the bolts, gaskets and seals. Make sure there are no visible wires and that the top of the casing is at least 6 inches above the ground.
- In the basement: Take a look at your water treatment system and make sure there are no leaks and that your softener salt is full.

Question: What's the expected life of my water equipment?

### Answer:

- A well pump will last about 10 to 12 years before it needs to be replaced.
- The life of a pressure tank is about 12-15 years.
- An electric water treatment system should last 15 years; a non-electric Kinetico system should last 25 years.
