Treatment Options

This is what a Kinetico K5 reverse osmosis water treatment system looks like on the outside. Usually the unit goes under the sink for a point of use system and all that's visible is the separate faucet. What's cool about the K5, and

- The K5 unit is customizable with FlexFilters to provide solutions for whatever your water problems or concerns might be.
- The system monitors the water and will shut down when the filters need to be changed. With a family of 4 using it for drinking water the filters will usually last 9 months to a year. It's recommended to change the filters annually. The filters have a quick disconnect and are easy to change.
- The EverClean Rinse feature uses the system's pure water to flush the system and extend the life of the filters.
- The QuickFlo technology makes sure that you always have a sufficient amount of water when you need it. The K5 produces more water, faster, than comparable systems.

Question:

What is a UV treatment system for water and do I need one?

Answer: An ultraviolet (UV) light can be part of your water treatment system.
