Ask The Expert

Question:

My City/Town water tastes weird. What can I do about it?

Answer:

City or Town water (water that you pay your municipality for) is treated before it reaches your home. While the water is clean it often can taste like the chlorine used in the treatment process. There are a few ways to remove the chlorine:

- You can let the water stand until the chlorine evaporates off. If you have a fish tank it's a good idea to do this before adding new water.
- You can aerate the water to speed up the process above.
- You can use a pitcher filter or in-refrigerator filter.
- You can give Water-Flo a call for point of use systems that go under your sink and are more convenient for large volumes.
- You can give Water-Flo a call for a whole-house treatment solution that will remove the chlorine from all the water as it comes into your home.
