Ask The Expert

Question:

I want to get my water and radon tested. How long does it take to get the results?

Answer:

For water tests, the turnaround time depends on what we are testing for. Bacteria, radon, and lead are common tests, all of which are sent to an independent lab for analysis. These results are usually available within a week. Testing for alkalinity, acidity, hardness, and specific minerals are done with a device called a Waterlink Spin Touch shortly after we collect the sample, so results are available in 1-2 days. Mineral analyses are complimentary

We use two different types of radon tests. The continuous electronic testing system collects data over a few days and the results are available when our technician returns to pick up the equipment. Scintillation devices for radon detection adsorb radon over a period of time and need to be sent away for analysis, with the results available in about a week.

For all types of tests, Water-Flo will send a complete report when the data is available.
