

Home ownership and all the logistics that come with it can be scary, but Water-Flo can help! Here are some of the scarier aspects of water and radon issues:

- 1. Creepy things in the well: Things that end up in wells that don't belong there: bacteria, spiders, rodents, roots and snakes. Seriously, we removed a ball of snakes from a well this summer! If your well cap is not up to code it can allow all sorts of things to take shelter in there. You can find more info on the well cap in this Previous Newsletter- and it is a simple upgrade. Don't plant trees too close to the well as it can cause root infiltration, which can block or slow the water flow. If your well head is in a flood area you are more likely to get bacteria in your water. We can test for that and a UV sanitizing light system is a simple preventative treatment for bacteria.
- 2. Creepy things in the basement: Maybe not so creepy but sometimes the treatment systems in the basement can be a bit overwhelming, especially for a new homeowner. If you need to know what's what, give us a call for a systems check and walk through, to make sure you have what you need and that it is well maintained. We take pride in installing neat, logically laid out systems whenever possible. If you're not happy with the current arrangement give us a call for a consultation on re-configuring or updating your systems.
- 3. Creepy things in the crawlspace: Sometimes it is necessary to run pipes to equipment through crawlspaces and we aren't afraid of spiders (or at least aren't admitting it!) and will tackle that area for diagnostics and service too.
- 4. Health concerns with radon: Radon gas is found in many homes in our area and is the second highest cause of lung cancer after smoking. Radon tests are required when you sell a home, but don't wait until then to test! Radon testing and mitigation is relatively simple. Radon levels can change over time so it's recommended to test every few years (whether you have a mitigation system in place or not) and if you've changed the living space in your home, such as finishing a basement, it's time for a test. Radon can also occur in water, but is less common, so test for radon in air first for healthier air. Our technicians will recommend a radon in water test when appropriate.

- 5. Things that go bump in the night: If you have a radon mitigation system installed and are hearing weird noises give us a call for a system check. Leaves sometimes get into the fan or the system attachment to the house could cause vibrations.
- 6. Unexplained water colors and stains: There is a lot of high iron water in our area, which is one cause of water coloration and staining (red/brown). You can see a video of high iron water here: Iron Clogging Water Lines. Sandy-looking particles in water are usually caused by sediment pulled up by the well pump, which can be addressed with a sediment filter. Cloudy water is usually just air bubbles that come out of the water in a few minutes, but occasionally, water can be cloudy because of high mineral content (hard water) indicating that a water softener is needed. Blue-green staining on fixtures may indicate acidic water that is leaching copper from the pipes. Neutralizing the water can improve the pH and save your appliances and fixtures.

Ask The Expert

Question:

I seem to have frequent water leaks. What could be the cause?

Answer:

Acidic water might be the cause of your water leaks. Low pH water can

cause pinhole leaks in copper pipes over time and other issues. Videos: **Acidic Water Causes Leaks.** Pinhole Leak. Ideally, our household water would be around pH 7 (neutral) naturally. However, depending on the source, water might be more acidic (low pH) or more basic (high pH) than desirable. And pH can change over time too! A simple pool test strip can be used to check the pH of your water. Or call Water-Flo for more comprehensive testing and to find out the solution options.
