## Ask The Expert

**Question:**

I have a radon mitigation system installed. Do I really need to re-test?

**Answer:**

Yes, you should re-test for radon every 2-3 years (as recommended by the EPA) even if you have a mitigation system. Radon infiltration into homes can change over time. Simple maintenance checks include:

- Checking your manometer (U-tube with the blue fluid) occasionally to make sure the fan is drawing enough air. The level of the blue fluid should be at 4 or lower.
- And checking the radon fan to make sure it's running and hasn't been blocked by snow, leaves or critters.
