Is Your Well Water Safe?

March 7-14 was National Groundwater Awareness Week, and now is the perfect time to think about the water flowing into your home. If you rely on a private well, you have a responsibility that many homeowners don't realize. Unlike city water, which goes through strict testing and regulation, private well water safety rests entirely with you.

Health departments and state agencies (DEEP in CT) strongly encourage private well owners to take a proactive approach to water safety. Since you can't always see, smell, or taste harmful contaminants, regular testing is the only way to know your water is safe for your family.

Follow a Regular Testing Schedule

Staying on top of your water quality is easier when you follow a routine.

- **Test Annually:** Check your water for coliform bacteria, nitrates, pH, and Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) once a year. These water changes can pose health risks or damage pipes and appliances. **For a limited time, Water-Flo is offering a free well water bacteria test (\$135 value). - **Test Every Three Years:** Check for naturally occurring elements like arsenic, radon and manganese. These levels can change in groundwater over time.

If you're not sure what water tests are recommended, give us a call.

Watch for Warning Signs

Even with a regular testing schedule, you should pay close attention to your daily water quality. Contact us for testing if you notice any sudden changes in your water's taste, color or odor.

You also need to be extra cautious after extreme weather events. If your property experiences flooding, surface contaminants (i.e.pesticides, fertilizers, animal waste) can be washed directly into your well system.

Always test your water after a flood (if the well area was submerged) before drinking it.

Question:

In a recent storm the area around my well head flooded and had standing water. What should I do?

Answer:

When the area around your well floods you should test for bacteria and other possible contaminants before using the water for drinking, cooking or washing. Call us for testing. If necessary we will disinfect (shock chlorination) your well to decrease bacteria levels. We will also inspect the well casing and electrical components to ensure there is no damage.

Water-Flo offers annual service plans for well pumps and water treatment systems. We recommend service plans for preventative
