Question:

Can I test my water myself?

Answer:

For some things- yes! pH, alkalinity, and chlorine all can be tested with the easy to use, cheap, pool testing strips. There are also more expensive well testing strips that cover about 16 common concerns. Both tests are dip strips and rely on a color comparison to read the results. While they are not particularly accurate they can be a quick, easy diagnostic.

Water-Flo's testing services cover a range of potential concerns:

- Bacteria, Radon, and Lead: These critical tests are sent to an independent lab for thorough analysis. You can expect to receive these accurate results within a week.
- Alkalinity, Acidity, Hardness, and Specific Minerals: Utilizing the advanced Waterlink Spin Touch device, we conduct these tests shortly after sample collection. This ensures prompt results within 1-2 days that are more accurate than dip strips, allowing you to quickly address any issues. Plus, mineral analyses are complimentary!

For radon there are DIY air tests and, less commonly, water tests. Around the January Radon Action Month, many towns will offer free test kits.

They are accurate **IF** they are installed and handled correctly. Like the test strips above they can be good indicators of an issue, but we recommend radon testing by a certified professional like Water-Flo. Our radon testing methods are:

- **Continuous Electronic Testing:** This method gathers air quality data over several days, with results available promptly when our technician collects the equipment.
- **Scintillation Devices:** These devices absorb radon in air over time and are sent to a lab for detailed analysis, with results typically ready in about a week.
- **Radon in Water:** Radon in water samples are collected by our qualified radon measurement professional and analyzed by a lab approved by the Department of Public Health. Results take about a week.

We pride ourselves on delivering thorough and precise reports for all tests conducted, allowing you to make informed decisions about your property. Trust Water-Flo for the peace of mind that comes from knowing your environment is safe and healthy.
